Transylvania Habitat Receives Lowe's Grant for Critical Repairs

Brevard, NC - In a boost to its mission, Transylvania Habitat for Humanity proudly announces the receipt of a \$14,300 grant from the Lowe's Foundation in 2023. This generous contribution was earmarked for critical roof repairs and replacements in Transylvania County, a key component of Habitat's Critical Home Repair Program.

This grant has already had a tangible impact: two local homeowners have benefited from complete roof overhauls, a crucial intervention that not only preserves the integrity of their homes but also safeguards their health and wellbeing. "The difference a new roof can make is immeasurable, both in terms of safety and peace of mind," shares Cathy Wood, Transylvania Habitat's Critical Home Repair Manager. "We're deeply thankful to Lowe's for their partnership and commitment to our community."

The funding from Lowe's is part of a two-year, \$6 million donation to Habitat for Humanity International to support home repair and preservation efforts in owner-occupied homes. Through this partnership, more than 75 local community Habitat non-profits will complete more than 480 projects to address critical health and safety issues in homes across the U.S. Since 2003, Lowe's and Habitat have worked together to help more than 18,000 people build or improve a place to call home, continuing Habitat's vision of a world in which everyone has a decent place to live.
